**MOTION TO RELEASE**  
**WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS AD PROSEQUENDUM**

The United States of America, via the undersigned Assistant United States Attorney, states to the Court as follows:

1. On June 4, 2018, the United States filed a Petition seeking a Writ of Habeas Corpus Ad Prosequendum, directing the United States Marshal to take DONJUAN POWELL into federal custody in connection with the Indictment that was pending in this Court against DONJUAN POWELL in the above styled case. Doc. 6. The Court issued the Writ on June 5, 2018.

2. Today, the defendant filed a Motion pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2241, Doc. 107, petitioning the Court for a writ of habeas corpus and DONJUAN POWELL's immediate release from federal custody.

3. The United States now hereby requests that the Court remove/dissolve the Writ of Habeas Corpus Ad Prosequendum that was issued on June 5, 2018, Doc, permitting DONJUAN POWELL to return to state custody.

WHEREFORE, the United States prays that this Honorable Court remove/dissolve the Writ of Habeas Corpus Ad Prosequendum, so that DONJUAN POWELL can be returned to the custody of the Warden, of the Duval County Pretrial Detention Facility, where he was housed when the Writ of Habeas Corpus Ad Prosequendum was granted.
