INFORMATION TO ESTABLISH PRIOR CONVICTION

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 851(a)(1), the United States advises the Court and the defendant of the following:

1. On or about February 26, 1998, in Clay County, Florida, Case Number 98-183CF, the defendant, Avise Hunter, was convicted of sale or delivery of cocaine, a felony, in violation of the laws of the State of Florida; and
2. On or about Avise Hunter, was convicted of sale or delivery of cocaine, a felony, in violation of the laws of the State of Florida.

For reason of the above-stated prior drug felony convictions, the enhanced penalty provisions of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 846 apply, and therefore, the applicable penalty for the charge against the defendant is as follows:

- (a) Count One - a mandatory term of life imprisonment, \$8 million in fines, and a term of supervised release of at least 10 years;

(b) Count Seventeen - a mandatory minimum 10 years imprisonment up to life imprisonment, \$4 million in fines, and a term of supervised release of at least 8 years.


